



Position Specification: NH Maori Representative Team Coach

POSITION PURPOSE:

To coach the team to their potential by implementing effective, well organised and disciplined training and game strategies and systems.

POSITION EXPECTATIONS:

- Assist North Harbour Community Rugby personnel to operate a comprehensive talent identification and team selection process
- Be available to observe all relevant fixtures necessary to select the team for which you are responsible
- Identify and recruit suitable support staff required for the organisation, selection, coaching and development of the team.
- Effectively plan for the season, trainings and games
- To select a squad of players, the number to be decided in conjunction North Harbour Community Rugby personnel, for all required fixtures
- Effectively communicate and implement the required skills, techniques and tactics for the development and performance of the team and all its players through sound rugby coaching principles and philosophies
- To actively promote and uphold the Core Values of North Harbour Maori and develop our Mission Statement
"Te Whakanui ai I te Mana" - 'Building the mana of Maori Rugby'
- Be available to attend North Harbour Representative Coach selection and game development sessions, where required.
- Communicate with NHRU, players, parents, coaches, referees, clubs, schools and other rugby stakeholders regarding the team.
- Submit a Coach's Report at the season's end to the North Harbour Rugby Union

POSITION ATTRIBUTES:

- A sound knowledge of the current skills, techniques and tactics required at representative level
- Proven history and experience in coaching, specifically in the grade for which you are applying
- Recent history of qualifications and/or regular attendance to coach development opportunities
- Ability to effectively communicate to players, parents, coaches, clubs and schools
- An understanding and willingness to integrate the North Harbour philosophies of development and performance into team programme
- Te Reo and Tikanga knowledge and practical application
